Reminder for Cemetery

Placing flowers on your loved ones graves is encouraged, but please use vases that are designed to be in cemeteries, i.e. have a means of sticking in the ground without rocks or other props. Vases are to not be glass and breakable as they cause risk to the lawn care workers. Vases should be heavy enough to not be blown over by the wind, and to be placed within a 4 inch radius around the base of the headstone. Anything that may present a safety hazard or obstacle to grounds maintenance may be removed. For any questions plot holders can refer to their copy of the Rules and Regulations they received when reserving plots. Extra copies can be requested from the church office.
